CALLOUT FOR APPLICANTS

AHA is holding a call out for Solar Subscriptions

Sign-up is ongoing until all spots are filled.

There is no deadline but acceptance into the program comes as a first-come first-served basis. After that, there will be a waitlist.

Energy from the solar facilities will be used under New York State's Community Distributed Generation (CDG) program to provide solar billing credits to low-to-moderate income Tribal Member's residences and AHA buildings.

- If you are a low-to-moderate income Tribal member resident on the Saint Regis Mohawk ("SRMT") Reservation you are offered the opportunity to subscribe on a first-come, first-served basis until the project is fully subscribed.
- The subscription agreement allows you to receive a certain percentage of the production from the solar facility at a discounted rate.

Community Solar generates solar billing credits for electricity production, and then allocates these credits to the project members pursuant to the applicable National Grid tariff.

If you decide to subscribe, you will continue to receive a monthly bill from National Grid that includes a new line that is a Community Solar Credit (in dollars). Utility bill totals are reduced over time by the Community Solar Credit. You would pay this utility bill as usual. You also receive a monthly invoice from AHA billing you for the Community Solar Credit at a discount. You need to make the payment or you will lose your subscription.
